









Val d'Europe

- Launched in 1992
- 25 Km East of Paris
- 2,230 Hectares
- € 6 Billion Investment
- Housing & Commercial





- Complete in 2030
- Additional € 8 Billion Investment
- Public/private Partnership



Val d'Europe

- Catalyst for regeneration
- State of the art infrastructure and public transportation
- Key new public amenities
- €10 private funds invested for €1 in public funding
- 70,000 direct and indirect jobs





Val d'Europe Disneyland Paris

- Over 265 million visits since 1992
- 1/3 of foreign visitors combine a visit to the Resort and to Paris
- Almost 5% of the 76.8 million tourists who came to France visited Disneyland Paris
- 6.2% of total income in foreign currency generated from tourism
- 5th largest hotel accommodation capacity in France







HafenCity Hamburg


- Overall area: 157 hectares (ha) on former port and industrial land
- Expansion of Hamburg City by 40%
- 2.32 million sqm new building
- 6,000 homes
- 56 projects completed, 48 in construction or panned





HafenCity Hamburg

- 45,000 jobs to be created 10.5 km new dockside promenade
- 28 ha public parks, squares and promenades
- Private investment € 8 billion
- Public investment €2.4 billion
- financed from special assets fund sales of plots in HafenCity (€ 1.5 billion)
- New Opera House




